

Traditional Indian plate rack – 58 cm x 59 cm



Before beginning, some information:

- The assembly requires a little time. That's part of the Indian appeal of these plate racks.
- You will need just a pair of pliers and a small screwdriver.
- When assembling, fasten the screws leaving some slack initially. You can fasten them firmly at the end.



STEP 1


Front positioning



Delicate phase: Take care to position the hole at the indicated distance

Start by fitting the 4 triangles at the front and back of the plate rack


Positioning of the rear attachment

Front positioning




The most delicate phase: the vertical interior panel must be placed the right way round

1/ The top of the panel towards the left / towards the plate rack's brand inscription

2/ The holes correctly positioned for the placing of the shelves


Then screw:

- the small horizontal shelf with the inscription
- the small rack at the back




STEP 3



The other racks for storing plates



Fitting the front racks:
Parts for assembly are wrapped in newspaper and the small metal rack comes as a complete part
Little practical tip: attach the racks from the back of the plate rack assembly (turning it round)




Parts in newspaper (photo taken from the back = best assembly)



Then fix the last rack at the back of the large plate rack (part wrapped in newspaper)

STEP 4

Completion of the assembly



Fit the hooks at the front
Fit the supporting bar at the back
